#### AWARDS

The organizing committee of **IABSCON 2024** has decided to give different awards to encourage the participants. The last date for applications for these awards is **31<sup>st</sup> December 2023** The categories are mentioned below:

- Young Scientist Award (three): Young scientists, faculties, researchers, and clinicians below 45 years of age can apply for this award under the oral presentation category (shall be mentioned during submission of the abstract). The award will be presented on the basis of the scientific merit of the work, along with the presentation made during the oral session.
- 2. <u>Best poster Award (three)</u>: All the participants in the poster session will be eligible for this award, which will be judged on the basis of scientific merit and presentation during the poster session.
- 3. <u>Travel Award (ten)</u>: A travel grant of up to INR 5,000/- or reimbursement of the travel fair (whichever is less) will be provided to the students and fellows who are below 35 years of age and are applying for the poster session. The selection will be based on (i) early registration, (ii) the scientific merit of the work, and (iii) a recommendation or forwarding note from the head or mentor, or competent authority with whom the student or researcher is working. An ID proof (from the university or institute where they are working) must be attached.
